

Remote Learning Home School Offer

School will...

1. Provide a mixture of lessons via Microsoft Teams / Class Dojo, independent activities and other relevant tasks (i.e.) to continue learning at home.
2. Respond to **completed** assignments/tasks.
3. Forward on materials not accessible each week to those pupils (parents/carers) who have informed school they need 'learning packs'
4. Contact pupils who do not log in to remote learning lessons to check in on them and their family.
5. Offer pupils the opportunity to ask for extra help if they do not understand.

Pupils will...

- Carry out each daily learning activity lessons unless they have a genuine reason that they are unable to.
- Log in to daily registration between 8.30am and 10am every week day.
- Find a quiet place to work free of distractions.
- Focus on learning during the lessons.
- Complete other enrichment activities to practice skills and extend knowledge.
- Use the chat function for learning ONLY, this is not a social media chatroom.

Remember 'Golden Rules' still apply.

Parents/Carers will ...

1. Ensure their child logs on to their learning platform every week day and is following the daily schedule and completing their work to avoid more learning time loss. (The DfE specify that this is 4 hours a day for KS2 and up to 3 hours for KS1 (with less for younger children)).
2. Let the school know if their child has any technical issues with accessing online learning during isolation.
3. Only communicate with the class teacher via the learning platforms within working office hours of 8.30am to 5.00pm.
4. Report any 'absences' as usual, via the school office email—particularly COVID 19 symptoms or positive test results for the child or someone within the household.
5. Ensure their child only uses the platforms for educational purposes.
6. Monitor the use of their devices for access of other online materials and apps.
